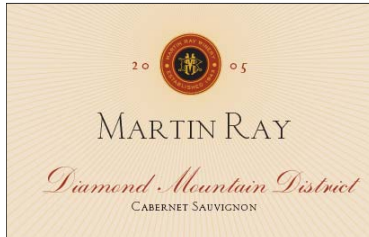

“Firm and spicy, with a sandalwood
edge to the aromatic currant, herb
and cedar scents. Remains tight and
structured, with good length.
