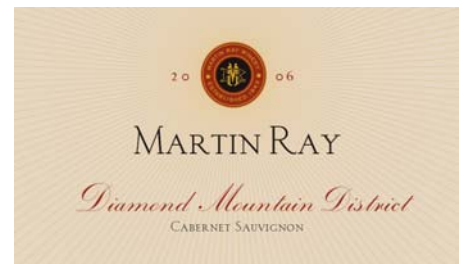
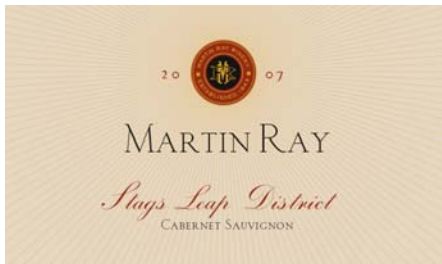


## YEAR'S BEST CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The texture is smooth, making this accessible now, though it’s also suited to several years of age.”-P.C.

“There’s a cool tone to this wine’s fruit that’s almost minty, with violet scents and tight, earthy tannins. The earthiness grows increasingly pungent and intense as the wine takes on air, the smooth tannins showing some harder edges. This wine needs time for the tannins to mellow; they will likely remain the primary flavor element as it matures.”- P.C.
