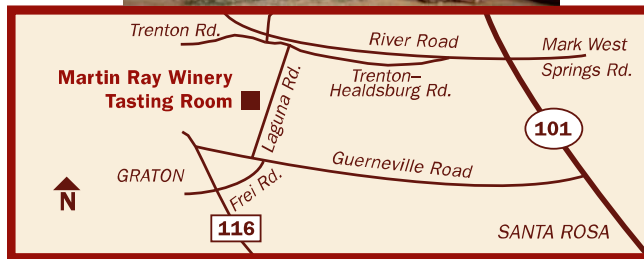


### ANGELINE WINERY
