Ripe orchard fruit flavors like peach, apple & nectarine. Fresh, clean bright summer fruit & citrus character. | Intense aromas of plum & blackberry highlighted by spice & toasty oak. Fresh, ripe flavors of black cherry, cola, plum & raspberry layered with vanilla oak that lead to a rich, round finish. | Brooding, layered aromas of sage, mint, black cherry & blackberry. Angeline wines were created to bring the market high quality wines at affordable prices.

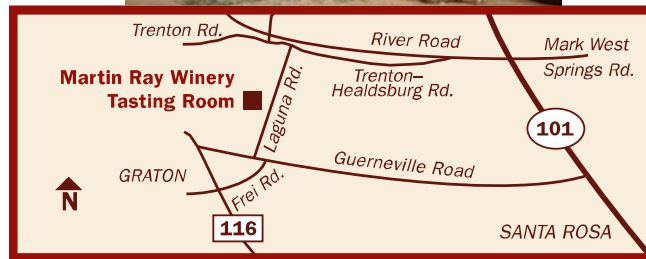
