Angeline wines were created to bring the market high quality wines at affordable prices.

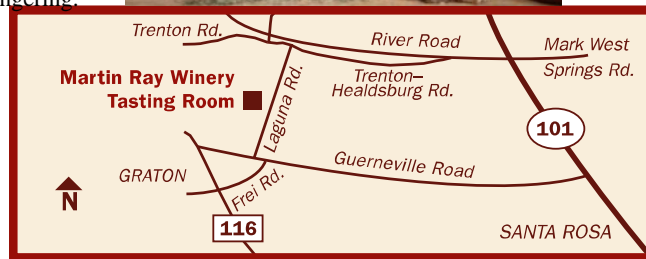
